Cancer does not grow in cervical cysts. Which develop when the glandular, mucus-producing tissue on the inside of the cervix is covered by the regular tissue on the outside. A cyst forms when any combination of mucosal membranes, fluids, or tissues becomes trapped. A little cyst known as a Nabothian cyst may occur on the surface of the cervix in many females. Their sizes range from 1 mm to more than 4 cm. Typically, they have a whitish or yellowish hue.

For the treatment of cervical cyst. homeopathic remedies are selected by taking into considering totally of symptoms and based further on individualization of the patient.
